Welcome to our Poterion Fairtrade Communion Wine e-letter with our latest news for Lent 2009. We are thrilled to be adding **Poterion Fairtrade Red** to our existing **Amber Communion Wine**.

The new red is made from 90% Cabernet Sauvignon and 10% Muscat grape varieties with 100 g of residual sugar (the same as port) to produce a rich, fruity communion wine that was generally agreed to be delicious at our communion service last Sunday, where the congregation acted as guinea pigs with the first bottles to arrive from South Africa! The wine comes in a screw top 75cl bottle, is certified organic and vegetarian and has

excellent longevity once opened.

Our **Amber Communion Wine** is made from the Muscat grape, lightly fortified to 15% alcohol content, pale in colour with fruit flavours and a balancing sweetness that has been generally well-received.



Has your life changed since the farm became Fairtrade?

"Of course! My life and those of my fellow workers have changed. After Stellar Organics became a Fair Trade accredited farm, the possibilities were there to improve our lifestyles and securities. The standards of everybody on the farm changed. Our houses are more than 90% electrified and we have the necessary sanitary systems. In the past, before linking with Fair Trade, all the money went to the owner of the farm. However, nowadays the workers also share in the profit of the farm.
